
Remember to sing our weekly songs often (we previously provided these links): The Alphabet Song, The Number Song, and The Days of the Week Song.

Eyes, suction caps (stamped, stuck on or drawn) and


8 legs (paper chain, concertina folding, string) and mouth.




What we used:

Our creation:








It's OK to fold or roll the 8 legs!
