



# TAPS Home Learning Update

Parents and Caregivers,

Just a little update.

As you are aware lockdown; COVID restrictions have been extended by at least **2 weeks** so learning from home will continue until **30<sup>th</sup> July, 2021** (at this time).

As previously stated, students are to remain at home and learn from home as there will be limited supervision at school. ***Parents are still not allowed on site.***

A few things to remember:
