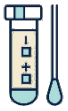




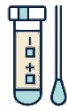
COVID Restrictions Some Changes



8 RAHT tests will be sent home on **Friday, 25th February**. You no longer need to test every second day.



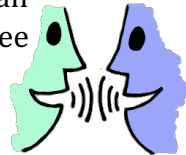
ONLY use these tests if your child has flu like symptoms.



IF YOU NEED TO COMMUNICATE WITH TEACHERS OR OFFICE STAFF

If you need to speak to a teacher, you **MUST** ring or Seesaw the teacher and organise an appointment. Unfortunately, you cannot just 'drop in' and speak to the teacher.

If you need to discuss issues with the office staff – again ring first, they may be able to sort it out over the phone for you
OR you can book an appointment to see them.



CANTEEN

We strongly encourage parents to order lunch for students online or send the money in with the student.

However, if you **MUST** come to the canteen, we ask that you order your child/children's lunch and leave as quickly as possible. You will need to QR code. This will be displayed in the canteen area.



PARENTS/VISITORS ONSITE

Yes! Parents are allowed back onsite – however we still must implement a COVID safe policy.

SO.....

- 1) Front and Back Gates will open at **8:10am** in the morning and **2:45pm** in the afternoon.
- 2) Parents are asked not to come further than '**Uncle Wilbur's Garden**' at the front at any time of the day.
- 3) Please remember that staff are not on duty until 8:25am so we encourage you to drop students as close to this time as possible.
