Over the term, Kindergarten students will be participating in the subject Personal Development Health Physical Education.

Part of our school's PDHPE program includes mandatory child protection education. Some of the content taught in child protection education deals with sensitive issues. The content will be taught in an age appropriate way.

The specific content is shown below:

- Feelings and body reactions
- Relationships and how people care for each other
- Names of body parts (private and non-private)
- Personal space (wanted and unwanted touch)
- Recognising and responding to safe and unsafe situations
- Strategies to stay safe, make safe decisions and ask for help
