## Dear Parents/Caregivers;

Over the term, Kindergarten students will be participating in the subject Personal Development Health Physical Education.

Part of our school's PDHPE program includes mandatory child protection education. Some of the content taught in child Protection education deals with sensitive issues. The content will be taught in an age appropriate way.

The specific content is shown below:

- 1. Being respectful
- 2. I have people who keep me safe (describing families)
- 3. Who do I trust? (helpers who can care for me)
- 4. **Body parts** (anatomical terms to differentiate private and public)
- 5. **Yes and no feelings** (naming emotions based on 'Inside Out' movie clips)
- 6. **Body signals and warning signs** (matching emotions to body feelings eg. butterflies = nervous)
- 7. Safe or unsafe (what body signals / emotions tell me if a situation is safe/unsafe)
- 8. Wanted and unwanted touch (naming ways they do/don't like to be touched eg hugs and how to say yes or no)
- 9. No, go, tell (practise ways of seeking help in different scenarios when feeling unsafe)
- 10. Strategies for staying safe (applying 'no, go, tell' strategies to storybook scenarios)
