Moving into Year 7 in a NSW Government school | 2024

Time to start the transition of your child from Year 6 to Year 7



To enrol your child in Year 7 for 2024, you will need to complete an Expression of Interest for Year 6 to Year 7 transition. The Expression of Interest (EOI) lets you indicate which school(s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7.

The EOI process is available now, but only until 31 March 2023.

If you miss this deadline, you will need to apply directly to your chosen High School.

After you submit an EOI and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a high school. When completing the EOI, you will be required to provide your child's residential address. We will get in touch with you if there are differences between the information you provide and the information the school has on record.

If your child will not be attending a NSW Government high school next year, please let us know by completing a **Placement Not Required** form via the online EIO process,

If you are unsure whether they will be attending a NSW Government school (you've applied for a private school, or you are moving interstate), we ask that you still complete an EOI and follow up with your school once a decision has been made.

The online process will guide you through your options and collect the information required to make the process as smooth as possible.

For parents/carers who are not able to complete an application online, please request a paper EOI form from the school office. EIO for Year 7 will close on 31 March 2023. You will need to then apply directly to your chosen High School if you miss this deadline.
