PM online

In Stage One, we are using PM online for home reading. If you do not have access to technology, please contact your teacher.

Reading a book a night is a great way for children to consolidate strategies they have learned at school. It is a good idea to read one story 2-3 times to work on student's fluency and comprehension.

Listening to your child read and engaging in a discussion about the text allows students to practice skills such as predicting, summarising in sequence and identifying the main idea of a story (Moral of the story).

Reading Eggs and Mathletics

These programs allow students to access literacy and numeracy at their level. Log ins have been sent home. Feel free to use these sites as often as you would like.

<u>Seesaw</u>

Seesaw is a great way for teachers and students to showcase their work with their families. Parents are welcome to like and comment on posts, as well as accessing private messages. This feature allows families and teachers to contact

each other regarding your child's learning, any concerns and happy stories. Please feel free to send a message if you have any questions or concerns.

Teachers are working hard during the day to grow and learn with their students. Please be mindful of this, teachers will generally reply to messages before school, during breaks (if possible), or in the afternoon (before 5pm).
